Generic kit list

This is only a guide – a revised version may be provided for specific camps

It should be noted that the Scouts and Cubs will be expected to carry their own kit, unpack it when necessary, and pack it away at the end of camp. Please ensure your name is on everything you bring.

ITEM	NOTES	TICK (/)	
		Packed	Labelled
Half uniform	Should always be worn to and from camps/events unless specifically instructed otherwise. Scouts do not need hats!		
Rucksack, Bag or Holdall	It is best, if possible to pack a rucksack or other bag that you can carry on your back. Suitcases are not suitable. If bags are not waterproof, then line it with a bin bag, everything inside should be packed in plastic bags.		
Warm jumper, sweatshirt, fleece	One to wear, one for spare.		
T-shirt or similar	One per day, one for spare.		
Trousers, shorts or tracksuit trousers	As desired. No joggers or jeans – they take too long to dry.		
Underwear & spares	One per day, one for spare.		
Socks & spares	One per day, one for spare.		
Nightwear – PJ's or similar	As desired. Sleep as you would at home.		
Hike Boots or strong stout shoes	Yes , it's a wooded site and we are hiking out.		
Wellies and/or Trainers	You will need <u>wet shoes or old trainers for water activities.</u>		
Waterproof Coat & Leggings	Taped seams as a minimum, not a pac-a-mac.		
Swimwear	Swimwear can be worn under old t-shirt & shorts for water activities. Not essential.		
Warm Hat, scarf and gloves	Dependent on weather.		
Sun hat, sun cream & sun glasses	Yes.		
Insect Repellent	Always pack between March – November.		
Sleeping Bag	3 or 2 season in summer, 3 or 4 for winter camps.		
Roll Mat & Blanket	Essential.		
Plate, bowl, mug & cutlery	Unless told we are supplying communal kit.		
Towels	1 for daily use and one for water activities.		
Torch & spare batteries	Head torch if possible, if not small hand torch.		
Personal Medicines	Medicines/Prescriptions etc must be handed in on arrival.		
Personal washing requirements	A definite must.		
Hankies or tissues	As required.		
Day Sack & drinks bottle	Essential.		
Pocket Money for Tuck Shop etc	£5 maximum.		
Free Time Entertainment	Playing Cards, Top Trumps, books, non electronic games etc.		
CAKE	Homemade cake is always very welcome ☺		

DO NOT bring the following items:

Footballs, MP3 players, Ipods, Mobile Phones, Electronic Games, Pen Knives
